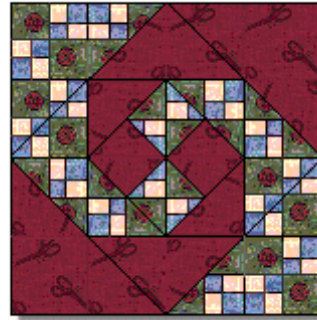


# Monkey Wrench

This makes a 12" block!...often also known as Snail's Trail!



## \*\*Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block\*\*



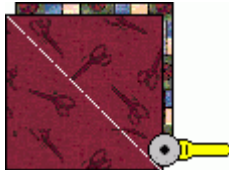
Let's start by using a rotary cutter to cut your small strips into two 2- 5/8 " squares ...



Next, stack your 3-7/8" squares and cut them at the same time on the diagonal, using the rotary cutter, and being careful not to stretch the fabrics ...



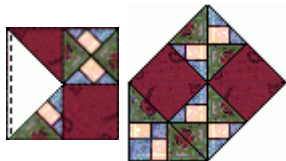
Do the same with the 5-1/4" squares...



... and the 6-7/8"...



First, with right sides together, sew your 2-5/8" squares into a four patch, using all 1/4 " seams...

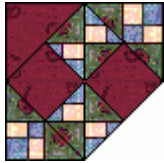


Now we'll start adding our triangles in courses around the center four square block ...sew one of the smallest triangles...Color 2.... to the side of the 4 patch ... [on to Page 2!](#)

## Monkey Wrench - Page 2



...and opposite it, the other of the same color...press seams towards 4 patch...



Now add a Color 1 triangle...



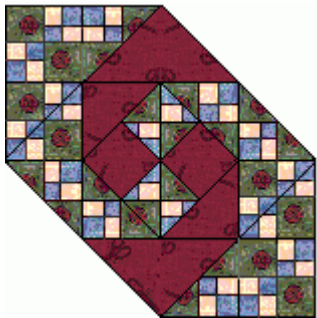
...and then the other Color 1 to the opposite side...press seams towards triangles...



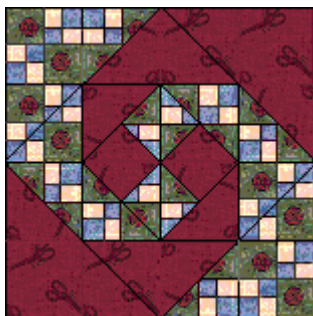
and go on to add the 2 (next size up) Color 2 triangles...



Then the next, to complete the next course, again pressing the first two towards the block and the last two towards the triangles...

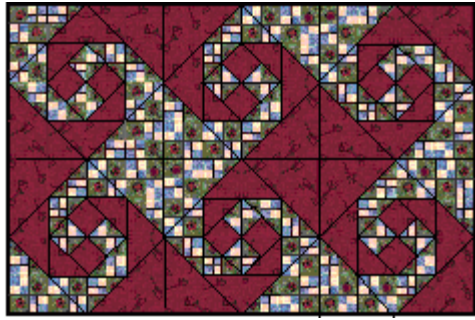


Now repeat this process with the last triangles, pressing seams in the same order...and there it is! ... [on to Page 3!](#)

Color 1

Color 1 needs: one 2-5/8" x 5-1/4" strip AND 1 square each 3-7/8", 5-1/4", 6-7/8"



Color 2

Color 2 needs: one 2- 5/8" x 5- 1/4" strip AND 1 square each 3- 7/8", 5- 1/4", 6- 7/8"
